

Years 8 and 9

Work will be set on Show My Homework (SMHW) at least once a week on a Wednesday. This will be a week's worth of work for your son/daughter to do in that subject. The SMHW notification may do the following:

- Direct the students to the new designated 'School Closed Work' on Moodle with specific instructions regarding which work to do and how to send work back to the teacher
- Direct the students to one of the school's online resources for that subject (eg. Educake for English, Hegarty Maths or Kerboodle for Science) with specific instructions regarding the work that needs to be covered
- Be linked to a worksheet/reading exercise/Kodesh learning exercise etc with instructions regarding how to communicate with the member of staff about the work once it has been completed

We aim to ensure that students will be expected to submit at least one piece of written work per fortnight from each subject to their teacher and the whole class will then be provided with feedback via email or via the SMHW online platform.

There will also be additional work which will be set via the SMHW platform to reinforce the students' provision and wellbeing, for example some resources from our British Values curriculum.

If a student has not been able to collect their books today, the school will remain open at the moment for the other year groups. Additionally, if we do need to close, the school will be open for some hours every day. More information regarding school opening times will be posted onto the Hasmonean MAT website.

If your child has an EHCP, there will be some additional resources available on Moodle within the **School Closed Work** room under the 'SSU Support Group' tab.

Year 10

The Year 10 examinations will be going ahead from tomorrow, Wednesday 18th March. The examination papers will be uploaded onto SMHW every day according to the examination timetable. These should be completed using Microsoft Word by the students under examination conditions (if at all possible) and then emailed back to your child's teachers. They will then mark the papers and will provide feedback. This will continue until the end of the examination weeks (Friday 27th March). We will then be in touch with you about setting work for the following week.

With regards to the **maths paper**, students will need to give evidence of their workings-out. We suggest that they take a picture of their workings-out and attach **one file only**, along with the exam paper to the teacher. This is also the case with any other examinations if your child wants to include additional material.

On receipt of the exam paper, teachers will mark the scripts and will provide feedback through ShowMyHomework.

We really appreciate your co-operation to ensure that our Year 10 students do these exams in the best possible exam conditions and return them to staff as soon as possible.

JS work for Year 10 will be put onto SMHW by the students' teachers.
