SPOTLIGHT: HIPE

For the academic year 2022/23, HHSCT were able to continue to support Hasmonean's Informal Education programme, HIPE. HIPE operated alongside the fantastic formal Jewish Studies aspect in the schools and helps ensure that Judaism and Torah are at the forefront of all we do at Hasmonean.

HIPE has 3 main aims:

- 1. To create relationships with every student in Hasmonean.
- 2. To create a positive Jewish environment around each student's education.
- 3. To teach and demonstrate that there is more to Judaism than the texts we study; it is how we act, behave and operate in our everyday lives.

HIPE has delivered more interactive sessions, lessons, shiurim and trips than ever before. Ranging from Tu B'Shevat sessions focusing on personal growth to whole school Lag B'Omer Takeovers, the HIPE team pushes the boundaries in informal education and sets a leading standard in the UK.

The HIPE office door is always open, a chance for students to come in, have a chat and talk about whatever is on our mind and I know that I'm there almost every break time with all my friends and I don't know what we would do without HIPE.

SPOTLIGHT: MIDRASHA

The Midrasha is the sixth form kodesh programme at Hasmonean High School for Girls - where learning meets life. The aim is to give students the skills they need to learn independently and inspire them to make the choice to continue to grow as young Jewish women after they leave Hasmonean.

In 2021/22 a number of new initiatives were introduced including Master the Chumash, an optional Chumash learning programme and a GIFT chessed incubator class. Results of both these initiatives exceeded all expectations.

In September 2022 a dedicated Beis Hamedrash was established for the Midrasha. Seating 70 girls, there is a double chabura (Chumash) period including one chavrusa period during which the girls enthusiastically learn together.

Additional initiatives this year include:


- an optional course on Jewish meditation and mindfulness with Rabbi Dov Ber Cowan
- a weekly spirituality workshop with Rabbi Yaakov Klein alongside our regular davening
- an alumni programme, beginning with a lunch and learn session and with plans to expand
- mentoring periods for all Midrasha teachers to enable them to better connect with their students
